Simonton* of the County of Tipton and State of Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Tennessee in the sum of Twelve Hundred and Fifty Dollars, to which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind our heirs, executors, and administrators, and each and every one of us and them, both jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

All The Condition of the above Obligation is such. That, whereas *J. W. Gay* hath prayed and obtained a license to marry *Ada Roe*; Now, if there shall not hereafter appear any lawful cause why the said *J. W. Gay* and *Ada Roe* should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony as husband and wife, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
