Know all Men, That we William J. Roe of the County of Tipton and State of Tennessee, are held and firmly bound unto the State of Tennessee in the sum of Two hundred and Fifty Dollars, to which payment, well and truly to be made, we bind our heirs, executors and administrators and each and every one of us and them, both jointly and severally, firmly by these presents.

The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas William J. Roe hath proposed and obtained a License to marry Mollie Pugh and William J. Roe hath any lawful cause why the said Mollie Pugh should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony as husband and wife, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.

You, or either of you, are hereby authorized to solemnize the RITE OF MATRIMONY between William J. Roe and Mollie Pugh of your County, agreeably to the direction of the act of Assembly in such case made and provided: Provided, always, that the Rite of Matrimony be solemnized in this County; otherwise these shall be null and void, and shall not be accounted any license or authority to you, or either of you, for the purpose aforesaid, more than though the same had never been prayed or granted, etc.
