The Condition of the above Obligation is such, That, whereas William J. Roe both
prepaid and obtained a License to marry Pearl Hollwell Now, if they shall not hereafter appear
any lawful cause why the said William J. Roe and Pearl Hollwell
should not be joined together in Holy Matrimony as husband and wife, then this obligation to be void and of no effect; otherwise to remain in full force and virtue.
